

Publication search in Jukuri

You can browse Jukuri with the categorizations in the right column on the page. You can for instance look at specific publication types by choosing the **Publication type** you want from the list. You can always return to the beginning by clicking the **Home** button.

The references that contain the publication as full text are marked by the picture of the publications cover. The references which contain only metadata are marked with Luke's grey logo. However also these can contain a link to the publication when you open the reference by clicking it.

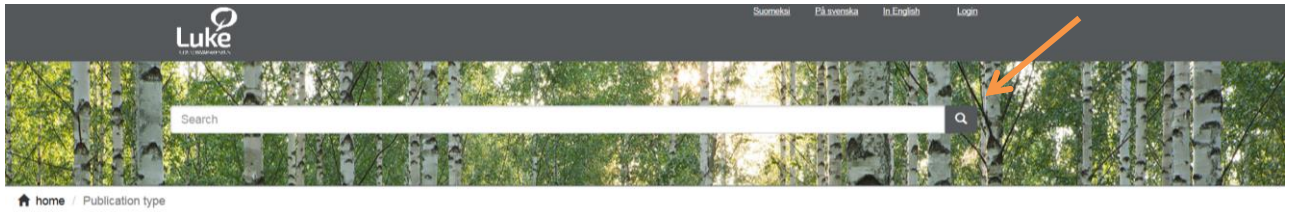

Quick search

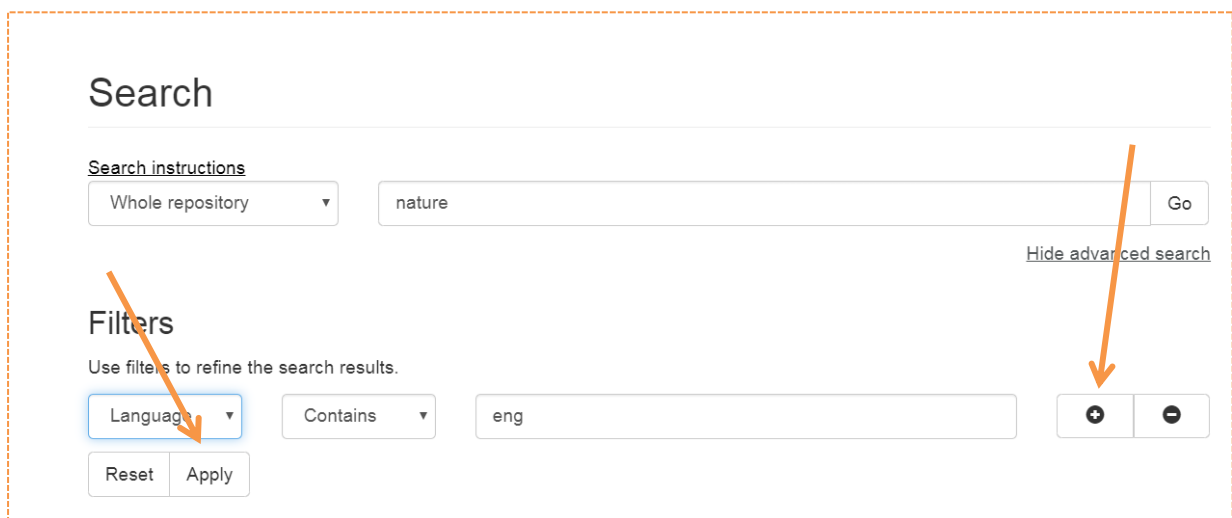
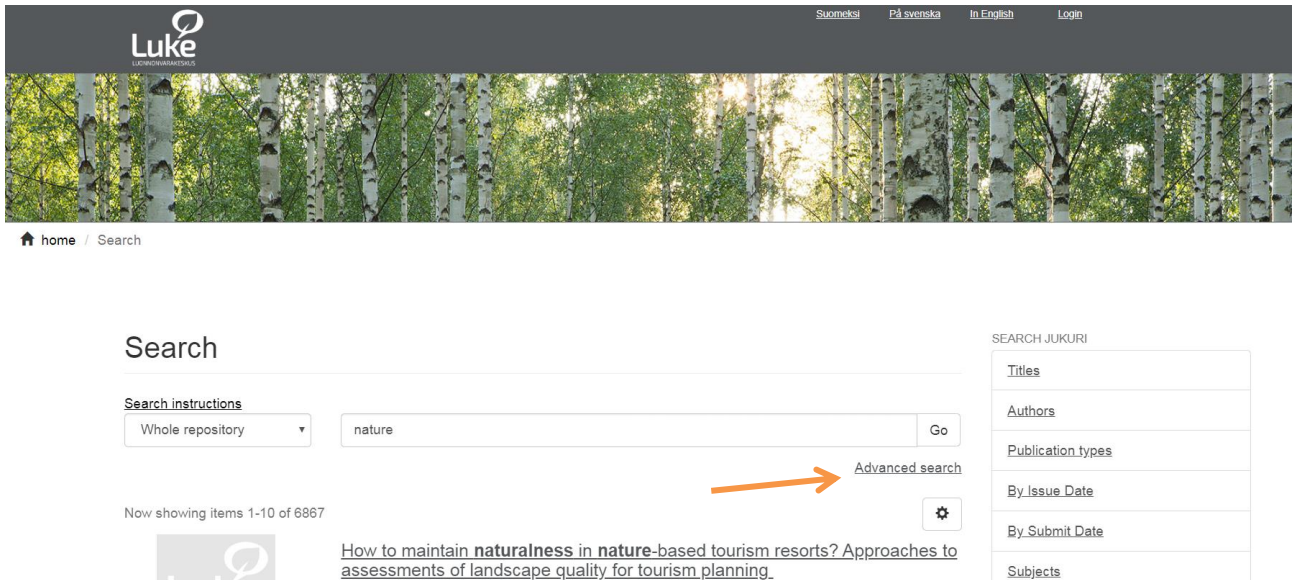
To make a quick search, type the keyword or words in the search box at the top of the page and press the **Magnifying glass** button. This gives you a list of all the references that contain your keywords. Note that the keyword will move to the lower search box.

You can go directly to the advanced search by clicking the **Magnifying glass** -button at the top of the page. This gives you access to the filters.



Advanced search

To refine your search, click **Advanced search** under the lower search box. You will be presented with fields to narrow your search results. In the left field, select the feature that you want to narrow down the search with, for example, the **Language** of the publication. In the right field, enter the actual limitation, in this case, the abbreviation of the language you are searching for. Press the **Apply** button to run the search. You can further refine your search by adding new filters with the **Plus** button.



You can search with these filters:


Author (name or Orcid id), **publication year**, **title**, **journal**, **publisher**, **language**, **subject**, **publication type**, **self-archived** (values *on* or *ei*, *on=yes|ei=no*), **project number**, **keywords**, **authors group's number** and **personal number**.

Arrange your search result

You can arrange your search result in alphabetical order or by publication year:

- Click the **Wheel**-button
- Choose the order you want to arrange by from the list

e.g. to arrange your search result from newest to oldest, choose **Issue Date Desc**.

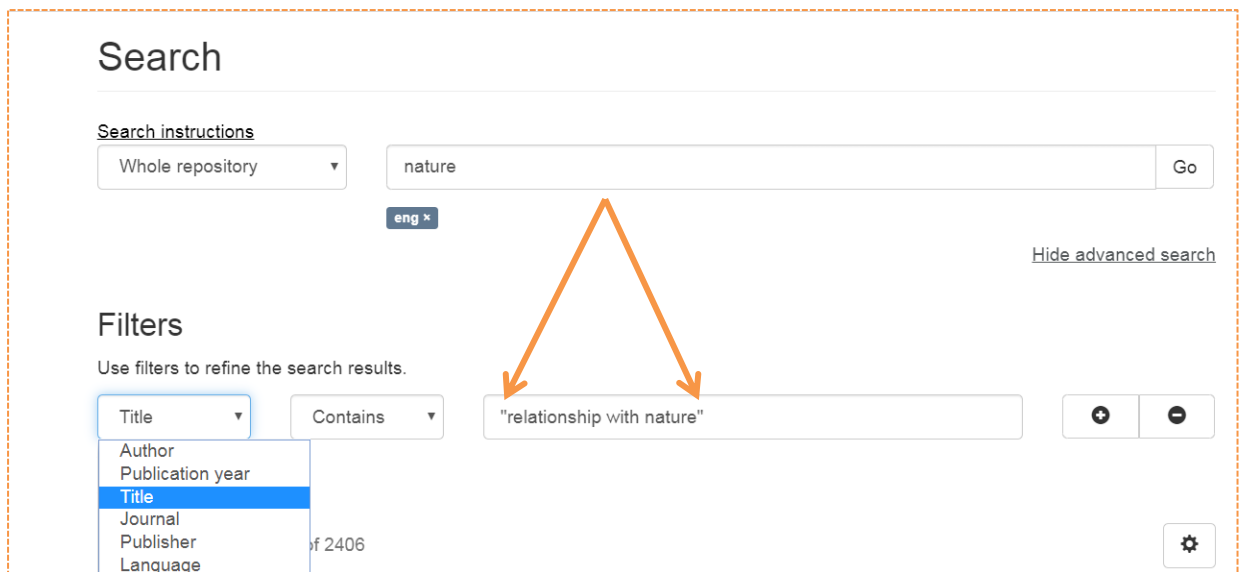
Discover

In the right column of the page, you will see the most common publication series, publishers and keywords for each search result. Click the desired series, publisher or keyword to refine the search with them.

Refine your search

Search with phrase

If you want to search with a phrase, enter it in **quotation marks**. For example, you can search for publications with the phrase *relationship with nature* in the title, by selecting **Title** as a filter and entering search term "*relationship with nature*" in the box on the right hand side.



Search with parts of a word

You can expand your search by cutting your search term with an asterisk (*). For example, search term *fish stock** will include both fish stocks and fish stock management.

If necessary, you can also replace a letter or letters in the middle of the word with an asterisk (*).

Cutting a search term with an asterisk is particularly useful when it comes to ensuring that all the publications of a particular author are found – the ones where the author is registered with his or her full name, as well as those that have only the first letter of their first name.

Cutting a word can also be helpful when you are not quite sure about the spelling of a keyword (for example author's name).

Using Boolean operators (AND, OR, NOT)

Searches may be refined also by using the Boolean operators. They are always written with CAPITAL LETTERS. Operator AND will search for publications that contain all of the keywords that are separated by it.

Example 1.

nature AND health

When the operator is not written at all, AND is the default operator, i.e. when the operator is not written, the search result will contain publications that contain all the words in the search box.

Example 2.

nature health

The search returns the same results as the example 1.

The OR operator defines the search to hit those publications that contain at least one of the search terms separated by it.

NOT operator limits chosen words outside the search.

You can use parentheses to specify the order of the search.

Example 3.

feeding AND (pig OR cow OR sheep)

The search looks for publications that cover the feeding of pigs, cows or sheep.

Example 4.

(shelf life OR storage) NOT freezing

The search looks for publications that address storage methods other than freezing.
